#### **Harvest in School**

As I have mentioned above, the Brother's of the Good Shepherd are limiting the amount of donations they can accept this year due to COVID procedures. However, due to the difficulties related to COVID, many families are accessing food banks who may not have done so before. I'm sure you agree, It is very important that we still support our local community in a COVID safe way. As a result, this year we are having a <u>non-uniform day on Tuesday 6th October</u> for a voluntary contribution of £1. The money raised will be donated to the Brother's of the Good Shepherd to support them with their good work.

If your child has PE on Tuesday, they can either come in clothes which you are happy for them to do PE in (please be aware PE is outside meaning there is always the possibility that if your child falls they may damage their trousers). Alternatively, you can send your child into school with their PE kit. We will give them the opportunity to change. The children will then come home in their PE kit bringing their other clothes home in their bag.

#### **Secondary School Tests**

If your child is sitting an entry exam for secondary school their absence will be authorised for the session they are sitting the test only. For example, if your child's test is in the afternoon, the afternoon session will be an authorised absence. They will be expected in school for the morning session. We cannot authorise a full day for secondary testing.
