


Polite Reminder

COVID 19 Update

Thank you for your ongoing support and co-operation.

Based on the updated DFE guidance, parents/carers will be required to wear a face covering when dropping off and collecting children.



The latest advice from the Wolverhampton Public Health is as follows:

If anyone is **unwell enough not to attend school for any reason**, they should be strongly advised to get a PCR test and not to return to school unless the test result is negative and they feel well.

To book a test on the GOV.UK website, please visit https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test and follow the questions. When answering the question, "Why are you asking for a test?", click on the option "I've been told to get a test by my local council, health protection team or healthcare professional." This will allow you to book a test at a test site or order a home PCR test.

Furthermore, in order for us to identify cases and minimise the spread, we ask that all children take a lateral flow test on a **Monday and Wednesday morning**. We do not need to know the result of a routine Lateral flow test unless it is positive.

If your child has a positive lateral flow test, they must get this confirmed with a PCR test. When you have the PCR result, please inform the school office of the outcome.

Please be aware, COVID-19 can (and is across the Federation) presenting itself in many ways. Symptoms we have seen include: a cough, raised temperature, a sore throat, tummy ache, ear ache, feel overly tired/aching and some children have had no symptoms at all.
